EC's Learn to Ride is a great program for people of any age interested in learning how to ride a horse. This program was developed in accordance with the Long-Term Equestrian Development (LTED) framework which provides a clear and stage-appropriate pathway for success for instructors/coaches and students, ensuring a safe environment for all involved, including our equine partners.

In Alberta the LTR program is overseen by the Alberta Equestrian Federation, and requires candidates to apply to undergo level assessments at appropriate facilities with appropriately certified instructors such as those found at SugarTide.

Should you pick us for your journey down the LTR pathway, we will happily help you submit the appropriate applications, help you to determine what levels would be appropriate for you to undergo or challenge, and work hand in hand with your coach to help you reach your desired outcome. We offer both study sessions and assessments in a low stress, well kept environment with appropriate horses and equipment for LTR levels 1-8.
